



Release/Hold Harmless

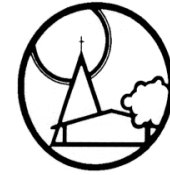

Information

Introduction to Hockey

This program is the second step of the youth hockey player development process at Georgetown Ice Center. Participants will enjoy learning and improving their skating and puck handling skills through challenging drills and on-ice games. Participants will be separated by ability in order for each participant to feel comfortable and challenged. Instruction will be high tempo, positive, and suited to the skill level of each player. There are five sessions to choose from with each session consisting of 6 hours of on-ice instruction. (Saturdays 10:00am-10:50am)

Cross-Ice (Junior Stars) must complete minimum one session of Introduction to Hockey before signing up for Cross-Ice. Cross-ice is the third step in the progression here at Georgetown Ice Center to becoming a productive hockey player with Grand Valley Amateur Hockey Association. Participants will continue to learn and build on the necessary skills such as skating, passing, and puck handling. The cross-ice program skates two times per week, Tuesday evenings and Saturday mornings. This program runs from Oct 4, 2011 through March 10, 2012 and includes 1-3 Cross-ice jamborees and or association exchanges. "Game Day" Saturdays will start approximately December 1. (Tuesdays - 6:00pm-6:50pm & Saturdays - 11:00am-11:50am) All players are required to register with USA Hockey online. There is a \$35 registration fee for those age 7 and over (6 and under is free!). To register, go to usahockey.com and click on the "register online" banner. Turn form into Jack Williams, Hockey Director.

Instruction includes:

- Skating (forward & backward)
 - Balance
 - Agility
 - Striding
 - Power Turning
 - "Edge" Awareness Control
 - Crossovers
- Stick Handling
- Passing
- Shooting
- Cross-ice games
- Fun Games

Full equipment [helmet, shoulder pads, elbow pads, pants, shin guards, stick and skates] is required.

Payment Policy

(Introduction to Hockey)

The applicable payment is due with this registration and paid in full before the player will be allowed on the ice.

(Cross-Ice)

The applicable deposit is due with this registration. The remaining balance is payable in full or in monthly installments, due on the first of each month, commencing on October 1, 2011. All fees must be paid in full prior to December 31, 2011. *Players will not be permitted to skate if fees remain unpaid after December 31, 2011.*

Refunds (Introduction to Hockey & Cross-Ice)

The registration fee is non-refundable, but transferable to other in-house programs. For any skater who becomes medically unable to continue skating, annual fees will be prorated based on ice use, and any excess payment will be refunded. An incident report along with medical documentation will need to be filed in order to process any refund. If a skater withdraws for any other reason, the parents or guardians are still responsible for ALL payments that were due before the date of withdrawal, according to the payment schedule listed above. I agree to provide all of the required information, and I understand and agree to comply with all terms and conditions herein. I have read and understand the Grand Valley Amateur Hockey Association (GVAHA) Code of Conduct and do hereby agree to comply with all the Rules of Conduct.
