

**GEORGETOWN TOWNSHIP ELECTION COMMISSION  
MEETING MINUTES-Monday, April 12, 2010**

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by Chairperson Del South.

Chairs make an additional \$25 if there are no mistakes in their canvass material.
- c. The pay rate has already been established by the Township as \$80 per each Receiving Board member (other than a Township employee).
- d. There will not be an Absentee Counting Board for the School Election.

- e. The Ottawa County Clerk's office has indicated that they plan to process the invoices for the election as quickly as possible so that election inspectors would not have to wait a long period of time for their paychecks.
