Education

- Attended the 8th Annual Winter Educational Seminar for Michigan Fire Inspectors. This was held in Lansing at the Kellogg Conference Center on February 7 & 8.

Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- Record and file the investigation report on the fire at 6655 Center Industrial Drive.
- Investigate the origin and cause of a rubbish fire in the front yard of 6011 – 22nd Ave. Write up, record, and file the investigation report.
- Investigate the origin and cause of the house fire at 4170 Blair Street with Deputy Chief Doug Poolman.

Other

- Submitted the January month end report to Chief Hamming.
- Recorded fire inspections in Firehouse module.
- Met with Captain McIntyre to review the new Zico airpack brackets for Engine 821.
- Checked out a citizen complaint of a waste disposal company putting sand over Pheasant Run Dr. between Heritage and Yorkshire. The company's truck had blown a hydraulic line and they were in the process of putting soak up down and cleaning up the road.
- Checked out the exact location of Riester Street for Central Dispatch.
- Reviewed the automatic fire sprinkler print for the addition to Meijer, 550 Baldwin, with Chuck Dyk from PCI.
- Plan Review – Revised site plan for Georgetown Shores No. 6.
- Per 890's request fire quadrant 825's "Fire Alarm" response was changed and a copy of the change was sent to Central Dispatch so they could update their files.
- Worked with Dave Fontaine from Central Dispatch on the address's they had for Gleneagle Trail. They still showed a Gleneagle Court that no longer exists. This court was eliminated and joined with Gleneagle Trail.
- Had a phone conversation with Tom Van Dyke, architect for Cottonwood CRC, in reference to the proposed canopy to be built on the front of the church.
- Met with Brian Gardner, Campus View Apartments, reference the issues that were found when I did the inspection at the Delta Zeta Sorority house.
- Met with Dan Janiski, owner of Great Lakes Fire Protection, reference the fire sprinkler system they would be installing at Meijer, 550 Baldwin and gave him a copy of the Fire Department Specification we require here in Georgetown Township.
- Received and filed the Title III chemical survey from Meijer, 550 Baldwin.
- Met with Jeff Ervin, Rockford Construction Project Superintendent for the Meijer addition, reference the improper installation of the 10" underground piping coming into the building for the fire protection sprinkler system. Jeff has contacted the contractor who installed it and it will be corrected.
- Performed the annual fire safety inspection of the Ottawa County Jail with Lt. Steve Barr.
- Plan Review – Revised plan for Cottonwood Veterinary Clinic, 7666 Cottonwood Drive.
- Met with Loran Serne, PCI electrical inspector, at 62 Mill Street. Electrical contractor has installed a new double meter socket and will be energizing the east half of the residence to get the furnace operating so they don't have any frozen water pipes.
- Met with Pam at the Georgetown Library reference changing some egress door locks around to make the assembly room more user friendly.
- Received fire prevention books from HME for our fire safety programs.

- A citizen called and requested us (Chief Hamming and I) to check out a brush pile that he wanted to burn. Everything checked out ok and he was given the ok to burn.
- Preliminary review of the proposed business and residential complex for the NW corner of 36th Ave. and Baldwin Street.
- Write up and submit the 2005-year end report to Chief Hamming.
- Worked with Captain McIntyre with getting the State of Michigan's vehicle equipment requirements to be licensed as a MFR vehicle.
- Create and type up a new Preinspection letter and list to be sent out to area businesses prior to the fire inspector coming for a fire safety inspection.
- Met with Chuck Dyk, PCI building inspector, at the old Strikers facility, 303 Baldwin to check out what kind of update the new tenants were doing and to see if they had adequate egress for this new occupancy.
- Went around the township checking our radio reception of Channel 13.
- Stopped by Brookmeadow Apartments office and talked with Randy Nordman, property manager, about cars parking in the no parking areas and our fire apparatus not being able to get in. He stated he would send out a memo to all tenants about this issue. He also stated that he would put in the memo that if this situation comes up again that we could and possibly would have those vehicles impounded.
- Plan Review – (PUD0603) Ed DeVries Properties Inc., SW corner of 44th Street and 8th Ave. Proposed business and residential complex.
- Plan Review – (ST0601) Jore Retail, 2460 Chicago Drive. Building demolition and addition of a new structure.

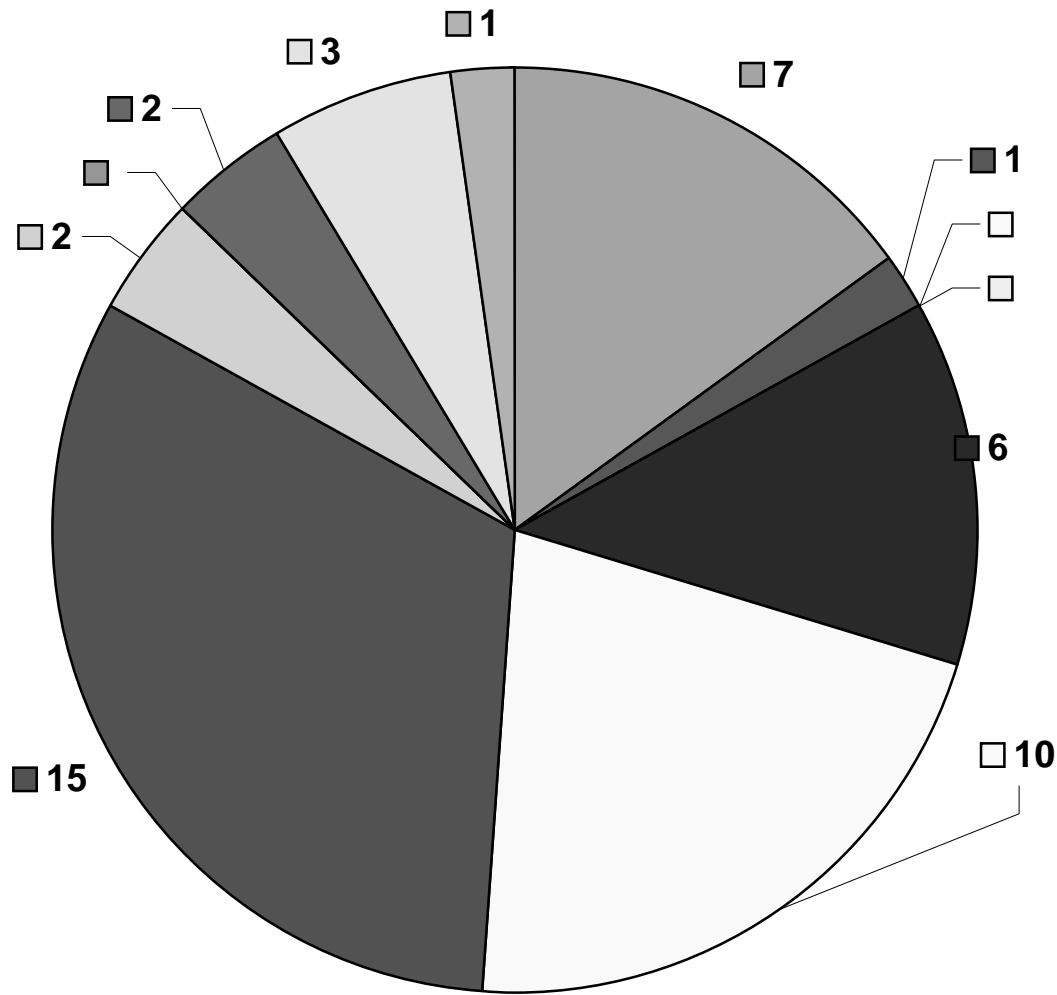
