CONTRACT AND PAYMENT TERMS

Contract period will extend from: April 2006 to November 2006

Billing will occur following each application. Price to increase by 3% each year for the applications in 2004 and 2005.

Terms of payment will be Net 15 days from invoice date. The undersigned agrees to pay a rebilling charge of 2% per Month (24% per annum) on all unpaid balances after 15 days with a minimum re-billing charge of \$1.00. A service charge will be assessed for any returned checks. In the event it becomes necessary to enforce payment, Customer agrees to pay all collection, attorney and/or court costs incurred by Contractor.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

We hereby agree to furnish labor, materials, supplies, and equipment in accordance with this proposal for the rate(s) stated. Any alterations or deviations from the above specifications involving extra costs will be executed only upon written authorization, and will incur extra charge as determined by Contractor. Any additions or alterations to the property being maintained which increases Contractor's costs, will also be charged to the Customer. All agreements are contingent upon strikes, accidents, excessive commodity increases (including, but not limited to, market prices in fuel cost), or delays beyond Contractor's control. Customer shall carry fire, tornado, and other necessary insurance. Contractor is fully licensed and insured for any damages for its work performed. Either party, upon 30 day written notification, may terminate this Contract. At the time of termination, Customer is responsible for all costs incurred to date on the property, including all materials and labor, which may include a difference in value of what is owed and what has actually been billed to date.
