Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- Follow up on water flow alarm at 550 Baldwin, Meijer on System #6. This was caused by possibly crossing some wires during demolition.
- Investigated the attempted arson of a residence at 8710 – 24th Ave. This scene was turned over to the Ottawa County Sheriff's Department.

- Investigated the fire scene at 4612 Van Buren. Took photo's and measurements of residence and wrote up report. Once we were don with our investigation Chief Hamming contacted State Farm Insurance and advised them that of such and the security of the house was their responsibility.
- Performed a preliminary investigation on the origin and cause of the barn fire at 8454 – 10th Ave. Interviewed property owner and those employees present at the time of the fire. Deputy Chief Poolman and I sketched out and took measurements of the fire area.

Other

- Met with Pete at Kuperus Trucking to put new master key in Knox Box.
- Put material together to send to NFPA for my Fire Inspector I re-certification.
- Met with Rockford Construction at Meijer in reference to getting the dry pipe sprinkler system air compressor wired to the proper electrical panel.
- Assisted Dave Fontaine with the proper names and location for Longtail Dr., Twin Lakes, and Unity Dr.
- Witnessed the trip test on the new dry pipe sprinkler system at Meijer with Rockford Construction, Great Lakes Fire Protection, EPS, and Meijer Loss Prevention. EPS has to clear up some issues with the alarm panel.
- Plan Review – 4440 Chicago Drive, Wiseman's Corner (Warren Buscher Properties). Chief and I met to go over proper fire hydrant placement for this site.
- Met with Laurie, manager for Dollar Tree at 7500 Cottonwood. They will be using the back egress hallway for staging of material to be removed from their back room that will be shipped back to corporate warehouse. This will be for two weeks only and then the hallway will be clear.
- Left phone messages on Betty and Nate Schneider's recorders reference having a re-inspection done at 7551 Thomas. Repair of the attic firewall.
- Filed inspection reports received from the State of Michigan and Fire Pros.
- Mailed out completed inspection and re-inspection reports to area businesses.
- Met with Dennis Meyers from JJO Construction at 600 Baldwin. This was to pick the area of the building where the new Knox Box was to be installed.
- Met with Captain McIntyre to finalize the color and quantity of hose that Chief Hamming is to order for new Engine 821.
- Delivered sprinkler test papers from Meijer to PCI.
- Dropped off Underground Piping test papers to Rockford Construction at Meijer that Team Excavating has to fill out.

- Sent out pre-inspection letters to local businesses.
- Inspected the new gate that was installed across the Van Buren Street entrance to condos on East Town Drive.
- Delivered NIM's paperwork to Station 2 for Chief.
- Code research on commercial cooking hood suppression systems.
- Chief and I met with the private company that did the control burn at Grand River Park on 28th Ave.
- Checked out addresses on Balsam for Dave Fontaine at Central Dispatch. There was confusion on where the split line was between Georgetown Township and the City of Hudsonville.
- Met with Chris Barnes from O.A.K. Construction Company. They are building the new Chapel Pointe Church. I gave him the fire protection requirements for sprinkler systems here in Georgetown Township.
- Met with Greg Johnson from Franklin Howerda Fire Protection at Meijer. Greg updated me on their progress with the remodel of the old photo lab and pharmacy. The old photo lab will be the new bakery and the old pharmacy will be the new bottle return area.
- Had Nathan Tennison from Jenison High School job shadow me the morning of the 27th.
- Met with Rockford Construction at Meijer to approve the location of exit signs on the emergency gates in the garden center.
