Education

- May 16 I attended the Tri-County Fire Inspectors training seminar held in Walker at the new Grand Rapids Press facility. Topic was "Industrial Application of Pre-Engineered Fire Protection Systems".

Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- On May 2 Chief Hamming and I met with fire investigators, insurance agents and owners of Wallinwood Springs Golf Course to investigate the origin and cause of the barn fire at 8454 – 10th Ave.

Other

- Typed up April's month end report and submitted to Chief Hamming.
- Attended staff meeting with Chief Hamming and F. F. Matt DeWitt.
- Contacted Betty Schneider, owner of the apartments at 7551 Thomas, in regards to re-inspecting the attic firewall.
- Assisted Matty with maintenance work on Truck 841.
- Worked with Dave Fontaine, Central Dispatch, on verifying the exact location of Cambridge Ct.
- Stopped by Purcell's Fleet Service and had them extinguish the fire they had going in a burn barrel.
- Compiled information for Rose & Westra, Inc., Environmental Consultants, for 520 through 550 Baldwin.
- Met with Les McElwee at Sunset Manor to go over the proper procedures on running a main drain test on their automatic fire sprinkler system. We also checked out the feasibility of putting a fire damper type vent in the firewall of the second floor dining room kitchen.
- Had Squad 871 serviced at Valvoline Instant Oil Change.
- Code research and UL Listing regulations on Commercial Cooking Systems. UL 300, IFC 2003, NFPA 17, 17A and 96.
- Met with PCI in regards to the failed fire alarm test on May 10 at Daybreak Church. Daybreak is to have their contractors get this system up to NFPA 72 standards and call PCI for retest date and time.
- May 15 PCI and I met at Daybreak Church for the retest of the fire alarm system. It was now wired in and monitored per NFPA 72 standards. We tested the system and all alarm functions operated properly.
- Chief and I met with John Turner, sales representative for HME Fire Trucks, to clear up engineering problems with the new fire engine prior to them getting it on line for production.
- Met with Jeff Ervin from Rockford Construction at Meijer reference updating the Deli fire suppression system to meet the current UL 300 standard.
- Captain McIntyre and I met with the EVS Rescue Tools sales representative at Station 1 to take receipt of the new power unit for the jaws-of-life.
- Received and reviewed fire sprinkler plans from Brigade Fire for the remodel of Sunset Manors main dining room.
- Met with Jeff Ervin and all contractors involved with the installation of the new Wet Chemical Fire Suppression system going in for the Deli at Meijer.
- Put together fire prevention handouts for F. F. Tom Datema's Cub Scout class at Station 3.

- Worked with Dave Fontaine on the address location of where the new Chancellor Drive will be coming out on 8th Ave.
- Took samples of new Fire Prevention books to Bauer Elementary for the Pre-K and Kindergarten teachers to review the one that would be most appropriate for this year's presentation during Fire Prevention Week.
- Attended the Ottawa County Fire Academy graduation on the evening of May 19. This was held at the Zeeland Cityside Middle School.
- Received an e-mail from Newaygo PD reference fraudulent fire extinguisher service being done in the state. I forwarded this to R. J. Poel so he could get this out to area businesses via the Chambers mass mailing.
- Attended the retirement tribute to Representative Van Regenmorter at township office.
- Followed up on a citizen complaint of someone burning on Winifred between 14th and 15th Ave. Found nothing upon arrival of the area.
- PCI and I witnessed the function test of the new wet chemical fire suppression system at Meijer.
- Sent out pre-inspection letters and checklist to area businesses.
- Made copy of 1178 Vos fire report for Chief Hamming. It seems that Borgman Ford is now getting involved with this fire.
- Met with Henry DeVries to go over the addressing problem at Cottonwood Forest Apartments. They are going to change over from apartments to eight individual condos per building.
- On May 24 I met with Betty Schneider at 7551 Thomas to verify that the contractor had indeed repaired the firewall in the attic. Firewall is repaired.
- Checked out the new Elmwood Lake on Balsam Ave. in Hudsonville for our Dive Team training on May 25.
- Deputy Chief Poolman and I toured Meijer to check out the progress of their remodel.
- F. F. Matt DeWitt and I gave a tour of Station 3 to two 3rd grade classes from Sandy Hill Elementary. This class was learning about citizens paying taxes to local governments and how the local governments utilize this tax money.
