Preparation and paving of roads which cover approximately 2165 square yards

1. Mill asphalt where it meets concrete slabs/gutter, storm covers, and/or perimeter of new asphalt installation. (1-2" depth; 24-36" from concrete.)
2. To clean existing asphalt thoroughly and apply an emulsion (SS1H) prior to paving. This will form a bond between existing and new asphalt.
3. To spray weeds with a weed killer as needed.
4. To wedge low and uneven areas prior to resurfacing. This will help with structural support and water drainage.
5. Furnish, place and compact a bituminous 36A surface coarse for a 1.75" average thickness.

NOTE: Superior Asphalt, Inc. does not warranty reflective cracking, due to condition of existing asphalt and/or sub-base.
