- Follow up investigation of the apartment fire we had on the 24th at 7680 Riverview, Apt. 202.

- Met with Les McElwee, Sunset Manor maintenance, reference how high a closet clothes rod could go before obstructing the fire sprinkler head.
- Finished up the street guide map updates.
