EXECUTIVE ORDERS 2020-75 AND 2020-110**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby provided that, in order to comply with recommended guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Section 1(a) of Executive Order 2020-75 issued by Governor Whitmer on May 6, 2020, amending the Open Meetings Act to temporarily suspend any physical-place or physical-presence requirements, and pursuant to, Section 5 of Executive Order 2020-110 issue by Governor Whitmer on June 1, 2020, declaring indoor events among persons not part of a single household are permitted, but may not exceed 10 people, and in an effort to reduce the likelihood of spreading the Coronavirus (Covid-19), the Election Commission of Georgetown Township will conduct the June 25, 2020, Election Commission meeting via electronic means using ZOOM on-line video conferencing at 1 pm.

- a. This is a Primary Election and all 17 precincts are involved.
- b. Applications to vote an absentee ballot were sent out to all eligible voters, not just those on the permanent list, due the Covid-19 Pandemic. All of the in-person precincts will be open; however, for this election it is expected that a majority of the ballots will be cast as AV ballots (since there is now No-Reason absentee voting) and processed by the AV Counting Boards.
- c. The AV Counting Boards were established for all 2020 elections at the February 10, 2020 Election Commission meeting.
- d. Under the revised law, Receiving Boards are to be established by the Election Commission and the resolution can be for all future elections. The Election Commission established Receiving Boards for all future elections at the April 14, 2014 Election Commission meeting.
