Dear Ms. Williams,

Thank you for the e-mail below requesting a pedestrian crossing on Bauer Road at 24th Avenue. The Ottawa County Road Commission has a continuing traffic safety improvement program and appreciates your interest in this issue.

While the road commission does approve pedestrian facilities within the road right of way through our permit process, it is the responsibility of individual townships to provide for the installation and maintenance of pedestrian crossings including paint lines, signs (provided by the road commission), and pedestrian facilities on each side of the crosswalk. I will forward your request to Georgetown Township for review and response.

Also, the road tube counters were put in place as part of a study to determine if additional traffic control is needed at the Bauer Rd/24th Ave intersection. It is expected that a temporary 3-way stop will be needed at this intersection this summer as it will be part of a proposed detour route when Cottonwood Drive is reconstructed from Taylor Street to Bauer Road. After evaluating the operation of the temporary 3-way stop, the road commission will then make a determination whether to retain the 3-way stop as a permanent measure upon completion of the Cottonwood Drive project.
