Dear Mr. Kossen:

As requested, the Ottawa County Road Commission has conducted a speed survey on Rosewood Street between 28th Avenue and Camrose Drive to determine if the existing 40 mph speed limit should be adjusted.

A recently conducted speed survey (copy attached) on the segment of Rosewood Street between 28th Avenue and Camrose Drive indicates an 85th percentile speed of 43.0 mph which is consistent with the 40 mph posted speed limit as well as previous speed surveys. A review of 2018 crash history (most recent year from the Michigan State Police) for the study segment indicated only one reported crash (intersection related at 28th Avenue).

Based on the 85th percentile speed and crash history review, adjusting the existing posted speed limit is not warranted at this time. Thank you for bringing this concern to our attention. If you have any questions or comments regarding the review process or findings, please contact me at 850-7220.
