TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER No. 1-21

Bauer Road at 24th Avenue
in Georgetown Township

The Board of County Road Commissioners of Ottawa County, under the authority vested by Public Act 300 of 1949, M.C.L.A. 257.1 et seq. herewith establish and approve a Temporary Traffic Control Order for the segment of BAUER ROAD in Georgetown Township as follows:

Type of Control: Stopping eastbound and westbound traffic.

Location of Control: Bauer Road at 24th Avenue.

Time Period: Duration of Cottonwood Drive road closure for construction between Bauer Road and Taylor Street.


Further, that all police agencies having jurisdiction shall be informed and enforce said stopping control when official traffic control signs confirming this order are in place.




