Mr. Carlton,

You and I spoke once about extending the bike path that goes around Georgetown Shores to the area of North of Ponstein Ave.

At the time w/ talked about the challenge of getting the golf course to sign off on that, where it would go, etc., who would pay for it.

As an alternative, is there any chance the shoulders of 14th Ave could simply be paved? There's currently about two feet of pavement outside of the white line on the edge of the road, and then about 4 feet of gravel. If that four feet of gravel could simply be paved we'd have a much safer area to ride in as we attempt to get to the bike path by Ponstein.

And those of us that have kids or grandkids to push in strollers would have a much easier time as well. I saw someone the other day pushing a stroller through the gravel as they attempted to get to the next side street.

Would this be possible?

Could you forward this to the utility committee?
