

SUPPLEMENTAL WATER AND SEWER AGREEMENT
GEORGETOWN TWP AND CITY OF HUDSONVILLE

THIS AGREEMENT by and between GEORGETOWN CHARTER TOWNSHIP, a municipal corporation, Ottawa County, Michigan, hereinafter called "Georgetown", and the CITY OF HUDSONVILLE, a municipal corporation, Ottawa County, Michigan hereinafter called "Hudsonville", witnesseth as follows:

WHEREAS, 40th Avenue is in part a boundary line between Hudsonville and Georgetown; and,

WHEREAS, Hudsonville has a municipal sanitary sewer main installed in 40th Avenue from M-21 to approximately 750 feet north of Van Buren St.; and,

WHEREAS, Hudsonville has installed water and sewer mains in Barry St. in Section 33; and,

WHEREAS, Georgetown Township has installed a municipal water main adjacent to 40th Avenue from New Holland St. to approximately 1,000 feet north of Van Buren; and,

WHEREAS, Georgetown Township has installed water and sewer mains in Port Sheldon Avenue, part of which is adjacent to Hudsonville; and,

WHEREAS, the parties do not wish to duplicate services, and believe it is in the best interest of both parties if the residents of one municipal corporation are allowed to use the improvements installed by the other; and,

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into a first agreement covering portions of the property as set forth herein on the 1st day of NOVEMBER, 1977, and this Agreement is supplemental to said original agreement;

NOW IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Residents or owners of property in Georgetown Township shall have the right at any time hereafter to construct and install lateral sewer lines from the buildings located in Georgetown Township along 40th Avenue to the Hudsonville sewer main, and be serviced by the Hudsonville sewer system, provided the number of installations do not exceed P.E. (People Equivalent) of 160, using the average rate of 3.7 persons per residential unit, and Hudsonville agrees to provide proper sewer and disposal system for such installations.

2. Residents or owners of property located on Barry Street in Georgetown Township, in Section 33, shall have the right at any time hereafter to construct and install lateral sanitary sewer and water lines, for residential use only up to 30 P.E. and to interconnect with the main and systems owned and operated by the City of Hudsonville.

3. All such installations for Georgetown property owners shall be in the following manner:

- a) Application for permit to hook up shall be made to Georgetown Township, and on approval of Georgetown, Georgetown shall notify Hudsonville of such application.
- b) No installation or connection shall be completed or approved to a business or a building discharging industrial waste, or similar waste discharged into the Hudsonville sanitary sewer system without specific written approval of Hudsonville.
- c) Construction, installation and the cost of the water or sewer lateral shall be the sole responsibility of the owner or applicant, and all construction, installation, hookup and operation shall be in accordance with the specific specifications and requirements of Hudsonville, and shall be under the supervision and inspection of Hudsonville.
- d) On completion of the installation, Georgetown shall pay to Hudsonville the following charges which are payable within 45 days after receipt of billing for charges based on current charges.
 - 1) Inspection charge
 - 2) Hookup charge
 - 3) Front foot charge for main, based on size of lot or parcel served
- e) All of the charges shall be equal to similar charges that would be assessed or charged by Hudsonville to its own City residents.
- f) Georgetown Township shall after installation pay Hudsonville on a quarterly basis the regular and standard rates for sewer services and/or water services and commodity charges in the same manner and equal to said charges as Hudsonville charges its own City residents. All payments shall be paid to Hudsonville within 45 days from the date of the quarterly meter reading.

4. Residents or owners of property in Hudsonville shall have the right at any time hereafter to install and hookup water service laterals from buildings located along 40th Avenue in Hudsonville to the Georgetown water main and be serviced by the Georgetown water system.

5. The Ottawa County Human Services building in the City of Hudsonville which is located on Port Sheldon Avenue, and which is adjacent to water and sewer mains which have been installed by Georgetown, shall have the right to connect water and sewer laterals from buildings located on said parcels to the Georgetown water and/or sewer mains and be serviced by the Georgetown water and/or sanitary sewer systems, according to Georgetown specifications.

6. All installations of said water and sewer laterals and services for Hudsonville property owners shall be in the following manner:

a) Application permit to hookup shall be made to the City of Hudsonville, and Hudsonville shall thereafter notify Georgetown Township of such application.

b) All construction of laterals and interconnections to the water main or sewer main shall be completed (except the meter, which shall be installed by Hudsonville) as soon as reasonably practical after the receipt of the application, and such installation and operation shall be in accordance with the specifications and requirements of Georgetown.

c) On completion of the lateral and hook up to the water and/or sewer system for any individual premises, Hudsonville shall pay to Georgetown for the following charges. All charges, based on current prices, shall be paid withing 45 days after billing:

- 1) Inspection fee
- 2) Cost of installation of water or sewer lateral
- 3) Hook up charge
- 4) Front foot charge for water main or sewer main based on size of lot or parcel served

d) All of the charges shall be equal to similar charges and costs as would be assessed by Georgetown against its own residents as of the date of installation.

e) Hudsonville shall, after completion of the hook up, pay Georgetown on a quarterly basis at regular and standard water and/or sewer rates and charges, in the same manner and amount as Georgetown Township charges its own residents. All payments shall be paid within 45 days from the date of the quarterly meter reading.

7) Each party shall have the right to inspect installations and connections in its own municipality, and have the right to inspect installations, cross connections and meters in the territory of the other after written notice to the other party hereto.

8) It is agreed that in the construction of sewer or water laterals that no "open cuts" will be made in any of the streets without the approval or permission of the unit of government having jurisdiction, and such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
